## External IRB Requests: Checklist to Prevent the 7 Most Common Delays to HIPAA Review

HIPAA Authorization:	
	There is a HIPAA Authorization for <b>all study groups</b> whose protected health information (PHI) will be accessed.
#6 – HIPAA Summary Form:	
	Selected PHI items match the list of <b>PHI that will be "USED"</b> on the HIPAA Authorization.
#8 – HIPAA Summary Form:	
	All entities that will receive PHI are <b>listed on the HIPAA Authorization</b> (in the section with bulleted sentences stating the people or groups that may use or share study information.
#9 – HIPAA Summary Form:	
	Selected PHI items match the list of <b>PHI that will be "DISCLOSED"</b> on the HIPAA Authorization.
#9 – HIPAA Summary Form:	
	<b>Justifications</b> for the disclosures of the selected PHI items are provided (Note: "Required for the study" is not a sufficient answer).
#9 – HIPAA Summary Form:	
	If patient initials will be disclosed, "name" is selected. Also, "name" (or "initials") is listed as <b>PHI that will be "DISCLOSED"</b> on the HIPAA Authorization.
Section D – HIPAA Summary Form:	
	If a Waiver of HIPAA Authorization is requested (i.e. to screen for eligible participants), Section D of the HIPAA Summary Form is completed and the <b>Waiver Agreement is signed</b> .
