eProtocol FAQ How to complete the Procedures section.



This section is designed to "build" the list of procedures that will be conducted and the drugs/agents that will be used during each procedure. Procedures are added one at a time using the "Add" button. Once you click that button, a window will open where you will select the procedure type (e.g. Behavioral Testing) and add specific details (e.g. procedure title, use location, USDA pain category).

<u>After</u> you click "Save" an additional section appears below the Procedures Details box. Under "Procedure Description" you are required to list all drugs that will be used for that procedure (if applicable) and you *may* be required to provide justification for specific procedures (i.e. blood collection, food and/or water regulation, prolonged restraint). Once you are finished, pay special attention to the instructions at the bottom of the page (scroll up and click "Save").
